(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER JANUARY 2021

To allow replacement works to be carried out on a decayed pole, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Waterham Road, Hernhill.

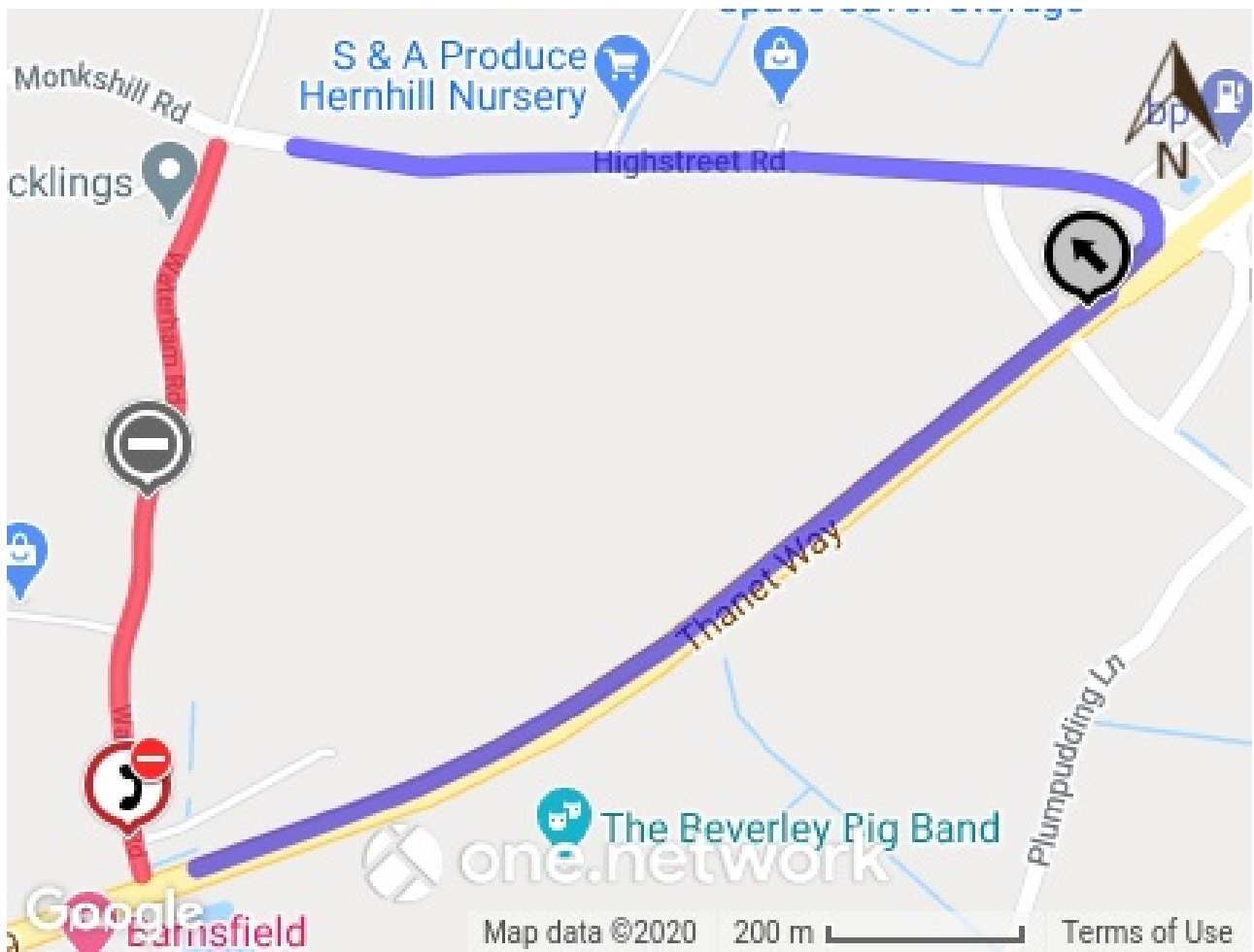
A closure is planned from 28th January 2021, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 30th January 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SE000000087371ONSA - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Waterham Road will be closed between the junctions with A299 Thanet Way and Highstreet Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole replacement works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A299 Thanet Way, Highstreet Road and vice versa.
