South Street, Boughton Under Blean

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER JULY 2022

To allow ducting works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of South Street, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 25th July 2022, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, with estimated completion by 29th July 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC417SECHA0000200777ONSA-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

South Street will be closed in the general vicinity of Beverley Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while ducting works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Street, Hickmans Green, Brickfield Lane, Canterbury Road, Nine Ash Lane and vice versa.
